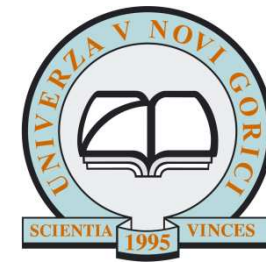
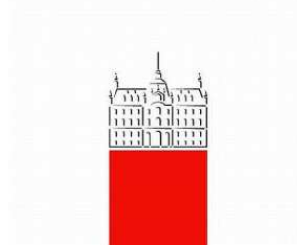

- SUMMARY
- There is an urgent need for changes in the field of HE legislation.
- We need new University Act; right form – legal framework
- Universities as public institutions with a full professional autonomy, strong responsibility and efficient accountability supervision (public, administrative and financial) - autonomy is the mirror image of accountability and responsibility
- How to balance the autonomy needed by public universities with the accountability required by the state - underperformance must be sanctioned - excellency in performance rewarded

- PI are established by the public/society to operate in public interest, good and privilege of people; science and HE are public goods.
- Current universities structure where the faculty is the employer and sort of legal entity, are counterproductive for efficiency, mobility, quality assurance and governance
- Universities as legal entities according to public law -with rights to ownership, academic freedom and its self-determined profile

- the roll of the student participation in the organizing, management and university governance.

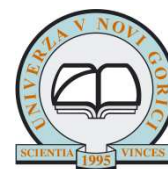

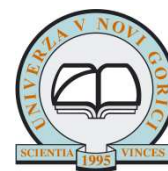
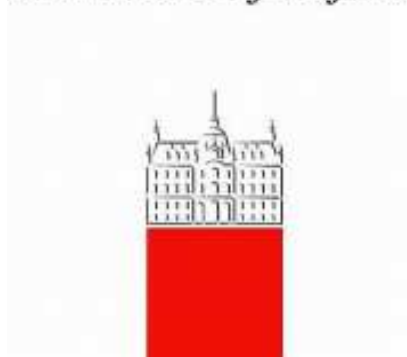
